CHOCOLATE LATTE was never far back, commenced bid racing five wide into stretch, responded while racing mid track to gain narrow edge mid stretch, kept to strong handling to wire, prevailed. CINFUL EXPERT dueled on the outside of rivals from outset, came three wide into stretch, responded to pressure throughout stretch drive only to be outnodded in the end. OFFICER'S DESIRE was allowed to settle early, moved up along inside into stretch, finished with a solid belated rail rally. BORN TO FIGHT was allowed to settle early, swung six wide when making bid into stretch, finished with a mild mid track bid. STANDOFFISH QUEEN dueled while racing between foes from start, gained narrow edge at the half, tired in drive. MOROS AMERICAN GAL wide of rivals from outset, failed to menace. APRIL MAY FLY well back at the half, passed tiring foes. BRIER HILL J J raced along inside in middle of pack, never a factor. BENT CROWN never threatened. SILVER ICON chased pace for half, faded. SHEKINAH'S RIDE forwardly positioned for quarter mile, dropped back. WOODLAND FAUNA was through early, outrun.
