EDDIE'S HOLIDAY was never far back along inside, moved willingly four wide into stretch, took command mid stretch, unchallenged and ridden out to wire. GAME PATRIOT dropped to rail after start, moved up along inside into stretch, finished with energy along rail to gain second spot. MAYDAY MAN was allowed to settle for half, circled five wide into stretch, finished with a mild mid track rally. SQUARE UP dueled along rail from start, gained narrow edge at the half, gave way in lane. HALF N OOPS well back from outset, lacked response when asked. ITS A BIG TOWN chased pace on the outside of rivals into stretch, gave way. OGYGIAN'S ROAR was not a factor. ROYAL CAUSEWAY stalked leaders from outset, dropped back. MAUIS FASHION SHOW hustled to front, dueled along rail for half, faded. TACAMO was never a threat. C D NIGHT was outrun.
