EMIT was allowed to settle in stride for half, moved up along inside into stretch, responded to take over mid stretch, went unchallenged, ridden out to wire. OKIE DRIVE rated off pace for half, came four wide into lane when making bid, moved up to challenged leader mid stretch, no match for winner and settled for second best. U DON'T SCARE ME well back at the half, swung five wide into stretch, finished with a mild mid track rally. BANKIN ON FUN well back into stretch, passed tiring foes. WILLIES CONQUEST hustled to front, set pace into stretch, faded steadily in lane. LOOK AWAY JOHN raced five wide from off pace into stretch, not a factor. WHATYAWAITINON never threatened. BRIKKTOWN chased pace into stretch, dropped back. A BID FAREWELL vied for early lead along rail, dropped back after half, eased in lane, crossed finish.
