POR QUE was allowed to settle in stride early, commenced bid racing along rail into stretch, responded to strong handling during stretch run, got up in time. OUTTA TUNE was allowed to settle for half, came three wide when making bid, responded to handling while mid track, finished well but too late. TRULY TRULY TRULY dueled on the outside of rivals from start, gained advantage at the half, went gamely when pressure to mid stretch, tired. SHOTGUN WILLIS failed to menace. STORM IN THE LAKE hustled to front along rail, dueled into stretch, faded. GREAT HOPE was not a factor.
