PHIL BABY dueled on the outside of rival into stretch, shook loose into stretch, went unchallenged and ridden out to wire while increasing margin. PRINCE RILLIAN was never far back racing along rail, moved up to challenged leader into stretch, no match for winner but gamely held unto second spot. SHADLY well back at the half, circled four wide into stretch, finished with a belated rally for show. RIVERS WEST stalked leaders for half, gave way. HEARTLAND FLYER raced in middle of pack evenly. REAL ACT failed to menace. C'EM BLAZIN was not a factor. SELF DESTRUCT hustled to front, set pace for three quarters along rail, dropped back. MR. DAMASCUS dwelt at the break, always outrun.
