PARODY outrun early, advanced outside entering the turn, responded when asked and wore down rivals the final furlong. ONE TRUE SUN chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, responded entering the drive, gained a short margin deep stretch but could not match strides. MASTER TIME dueled from the outside early, remained engaged through the turn, held a clear margin at the eighth pole but could not last. CHILE FRITO dueled from the inside but had nothing left. OVERTHEHUMP went evenly. EXPECT DOBBIN dueled from between foes and tired. MCCROCKLIN chased the early pace outside and tired in the drive. OOPS AND A HALF was no factor.
