MISS SHANANIEGANS well placed from the inside early, tracked the pace up the backstretch, inched closer entering the second turn, altered outside, responded to pressure when asked and wore down rivals the final furlong. LADY JORDAN broke sharp from the outside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, continued to show the way entering the second turn, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. MISS HOCKADAY unhurried early, advanced inside entering the second turn, responded and was gaining late. BARBY SUE went evenly. GUANABARA GAL chased the early pace inside but had nothing left. TICKLEYOURFANCY pressed the early pace and tired. EXTRACT was never close.
