WORLD WIDE WEB was never far back, circled six wide when making bid into stretch, responded to steady urging while racing mid track, got up in final strides. PHANTOM STRIKE within striking distance along inside from start, swung five wide into stretch, responded to steady handling throughout stretch drive only to be outnodded in the end. SILVERBDANCING dueled along ail from outset, went gamely along rain during drive to wire only to be outfinished in the end. PETE'S PRIDE dueled on the outside of rivals from start, responded to gain advantage at the half, responded to steady pressure throughout stretch drive only to missed in the end. SLEEVE well back at the half, came five wide into lane, finished with a mild mid track rally. YOGA hustled to front, dueled for half, gave way in lane. TRUE COURSE stalked early pace on the outside of rivals, gave way after half. ROY'S TOPS was never a factor. VALID HEART was never a serious threat.
