WILDPLAY stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded to gain a clear margin at the eighth pole then was all out to last. DU GOOD BABY allowed to settle early, advanced inside entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive and was getting to the winner. DELLA MARIE chased the early pace from the outside, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. MISS TACTICAL CAT pressed the early pace from the outside, held a forward position for the drive but had nothing left. DELAVERNE forced the early pace inside and tired. OVERLY TRICKY broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, held a forward position for the drive but tired. ROSEZITASELECTION showed little. MONARCH'S PRINCESS was finished early.
