HENRY SUNSHINE unhurried early from the inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the second turn, responded to pressure go gain a short margin deep stretch and outfinished HOLIDAY WEAVE late. HOLIDAY WEAVE allowed to settle early, advanced outside up the backstretch, made a bid entering the second turn, responded to pressure but was outfinished. GOLD COUNTRY CAT stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, made a bid to gain a clear margin at the eighth pole but could not last. MADE THE CUT outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded and finished well. OFFLEE TUFF could only improve position. QUIET KING was no factor. MIZZEN MAZE dueled from the inside and tired. MY TIME TO STAR dueled from the outside and tired. WOODSWIND forced the early pace outside and faded. INHOPEWEARESAVED chased the early pace and faded.
