### Footnotes

BOOGIE MUSIC rated along rail while never far back, split foes when making bid mid stretch to gain advantage, drew clear in late going. JUDYS FAVORITE SON allowed to settle in stride early, came four wide when making bid into stretch, finished well with belated bid. LITTLE WAGON rated off early pace, circled rivals leaving far turn, swung out five wide into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, hung in final stages. PAPERDONTSAYTHAT moved up between rivals to reach contention after half, gained slight nod three quarter call, weakened in drive. FLIM FLAM MAN trailed after a half, improved position in lane. KANSAS SANDMAN rated off early pace moved up on the outside of rivals to loom danger into stretch, tired. MR. FOURJAY chased pace to stretch, gave way. RED DIME SPECIAL forwardly positioned on the outside for half, faded. KEOKUK saved ground while forwardly positioned for half, dropped back. KING HIGH STRAIGHT hustled to front, quit after half.
