Footnotes

NOTIFY rated off early pace, commenced bid racing four wide into stretch, responded to steady handling while racing mid track, got up and drew off in late going. SHAOLIN stalked leaders along rail from outset, responded to gain narrow edge mid stretch, went gamely before tiring in late going. MESA CAY well back early, commenced bid circling rivals far turn, came three wide into lane, moved up engage leaders and loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. NATES MINESHAFT within striking distance along rail from outset, had no rally. MOUNTAIN GULCH along inside racing in back early, failed to menace. Q P SLEW stalked leaders for half, gave way. GUCCI BOY hustled to front, set pace for half, faded. BRANDONS HOT SAUCE vied for early lead outside rivals, dropped back after quarter mile. ESAU was never a factor. ROARING BLADE was always outrun.
