### Footnotes

P L CLASSIC RIVER allowed to settle early, circled seven wide into stretch, responded to handling while racing mid track, got up in time. BERNIES LEGACY was never far back along rail, came off rail into stretch, finished well with belated rally. THUNDER CLUTCH was never far back outside rivals, four wide into stretch, gained narrow edge mid stretch, went gamely before weakening in late going. SUNDAY'SONTHEWAY dueled along inside from outset, sent gamely under pressure along rail in drive before weakening in late going. BARLO dueled from outset, gained narrow edge at the half, went gamely to mid stretch, tired. OCHELATA TAH DAH allowed to settle while outside rivals early, came six wide when making bid into stretch, lacked needed late kick in drive. DEAL A KING dueled along rail to stretch, gave way. DEEP ROCK DAN was never far back, came between rivals five wide into stretch when making bid, gave way mid stretch. LUCKOFTESTARS forwardly positioned between rivals into stretch, faded. BADMOONONTHERISE was not a factor. ZYK forwardly positioned outside rivals to stretch, faded. DADDY WAGGS was outrun.
