EXPENSIVE PROSPECT dueled on the outside of rivals from outset, responded to steady urging during stretch drive, got up and drew off in late going. CAGEY LITTLE GIRL within striking distance from outset, came three wide when making bid into stretch, responded to gain edge mid stretch, went gamely but couldn't last. R F FLYNBAYAKOA was allowed to settle early, came five wide when making bid into stretch, loomed danger mid stretch, hung. LUCKY LIPSTICK came four wide from middle of pack into stretch, lacked response when asked. ONE CENT CINDY dueled for early advantage, gave way after quarter mile. WANDOROUS was not a factor. GINGER BRICK ROAD saved ground while forwardly positioned for half, to no avail. TOMMI TOMMI was never a threat. MS. DEMI was always outrun. SHAUNAS LIL TWIRL hustled to front, set pace for half, stopped.
