MOUNTAIN RIVERA well positioned along rail from outset, responded to steady handling to gain slight advantage mid stretch, then was all out to prevail. ABIT O IRISH broke to front, opened clear advantage into stretch, went gamely under pressure in drive and just missed in a all out effort. THREECLOCKFRIDAY well back for half, came four wide into lane when making bid, altered course mid stretch, finished with a solid belated effort. NORTHERN WATCH well back for half, swung five wide into stretch, finished with belated mid track rally. ALLEGED HUG trailed for half, came three wide into lane, finished with a mild belated mid track rally. ALL ABOUT US raced in middle of pack along rail, had no rally. FUN GUN chased pace for three quarters, gave way. PREACHERS LUCK stalked pace for three quarters, faded. WELCH was never a factor. NOT A BAD BOY was always outrun.
