Footnotes

SUPERIOR CAT well placed from the inside early, advanced entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and was clear late under steady urging. MISS SHILOH broke well from the inside to gain the early advantage, opened a clear margin entering the stretch but could not last. TEETAU MARIE up close outside early, chased the pace entering the turn but could not match strides. ELISHA JOY outrun early, was carried wide entering the turn when TINEY GIRL bolted, recovered to drop inside then finished well. CARELESS LOVE could only pass tired ones. KENTUCKY RUCKUS was no factor. LYNDEE JO chased the pace outside and tired. TINEY GIRL broke well from the inside, bolted entering the turn and was no threat. MAMBO MUSIC chased the pace inside and tired. FAST SENORITA had a steady fade.
