GLEAMING chased leader along inside from outset, moved up along rail into stretch, responded to gain narrow edge mid stretch, responded to steady handling to wire and prevailed in an all out effort. MISS NATALIE was never far back along inside, moved up to engage leader mid stretch, went gamely under steady urging to wire only to be outnodded in the end. EVERLASTINGLY within striking distance from outset, came three wide into lane, moved up to dueled with leaders mid stretch, went gamely to wire before weakening late. BAR BABE was never far back, raced four wide into stretch, had no rally. KISS ME CHOCOLATE forwardly positioned from outset, came four wide into stretch, lacked response when asked. SHESAUNA failed to menace. C J JONES hustled to front, set pace for half, faded. SOPHIA'S JEWEL was always outrun.
