GENERAL PARKS rated off early pace, commenced bid racing six wide into stretch, responded to steady handling while racing mid track, took command and drew off in late going. TECHNICAL EXPRESS hustled to front, dueled along rail to mid stretch, went gamely but unable to match strides with winner late. WACO HUG well back at the half, circled eight wide into stretch, finished well with a belated mid track rally. SERVICE HAWK within striking distance

along inside from outset, moved up to loom danger into stretch, flattened out. WHISKEY MAN chased pace for half, responded to gain clear advantage three quarter call, gave way in lane. MAKE THE GRADE raced along inside while forwardly position into stretch, lacked response. MR JO BANGLES trailed early, circled ten wide into stretch, improved position. SECT. PERFECTSTORM raced well back along inside into stretch, lacked bid. WHO'S HUSSONET forwardly positioned outside rivals to stretch, gave way. MAJOR REALITY stalked leaders on the outside to stretch, faded. H K'S VICTORY was not a factor. TWO JAYS SECRET was not a threat. BONNIE'S PROSPECT stalked leaders along inside into stretch, faded steadily in lane.
