D FINE OKIE chased pace from outset, came around rivals entering lane, under mild urging took command mid stretch, remained clear to wire while being ridden out. PLAID forwardly positioned from start, moved up along rail to loom danger, no match for winner in late going, but best of others. WHERE WOODY BEA set pace for three quarters, tired. DYNABIN failed to menace. HILARY HUNTER was not a factor. VICTORY BRIDE was always outrun.
