Footnotes

EN PASSANT unhurried early, advanced inside up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the drive, awaited room upper stretch, got through along the rail and was clear late. COMPETENT broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, dueled through the second turn, remained forward for the drive but could not match strides. MAE B TODAY stumbled at the start, recovered to be far back early, advanced outside up the backstretch, was forced five wide into the drive, responded but faltered late. KIPSANDY well placed from the outside early, dueled through the second turn but could not keep pace. WHEN WILLY WIN could only pass tired ones. EIGHTY MILLION was no factor. PICO PICO was no threat. FROSTY GENERAL forced the early pace outside and gave way.
