C'EM BLAZIN was rated off pace while not far back, came three wide when making bid into stretch, responded to handling, gained narrow edge mid stretch, kept to task and drew clear late. MIKA'S TOPGUN stalked leaders on the outside from the outset, three wide into stretch, moved up to duel with leader mid stretch, went gamely before weakening in late going. OKIE PROSPECT allowed to settle while outside rivals from outset, circled six wide into stretch, finished with a belated mid track rally. GREAT AFFAIR within striking distance along inside from start, moved up to duel for lead at the half, gave way in lane. DOUBLELUCKYLIONEL dueled while between foes from start, responded to gain narrow edge at the half, went gamely into stretch, gave way mid

stretch. EUROFLAIR raced in middle of pack, came four wide into stretch, lacked response. MAJOR KASH well back from outset, failed to menace. CROW CHIEF was never a factor. ALERT THE GIRLS showed little. EL RELANPAGO well back from outset, never threatened. A J'S CAT hustled to front, dueled for half, dropped back. BABY WISH broke alertly to vie for early lead, faded steadily after quarter mile. COLONEL RAY BOY was outrun. LIGHTNING INTHEHAY was never close, eased in lane, crossed finish.
