PERFECT GEM broke to front, rated well with clear lead into stretch, went unchallenged in drive while being ridden out. LITTLE SIS was never far back, came three wide into stretch, no match for winner but clear of others. WHAT THE WORLD well back from start, circled leaving far turn, came eight wide into stretch, finished with a solid belated mid track rally. NETTIE HUGHES chased pace to mid stretch, gave way. TWO TOWN came five wide from middle of pack into stretch, failed to menace. KIT CAT KITTY well back early, improved position. LINDAS LUCKY LADY trailed for three quarters, passed tiring foes. GET SOME ACTION was not a factor. ADDISON TRAIL forwardly positioned for half, faded. CAPTURE A RAINBOW was never a threat. MIDNIGHT FRIEND stalked leaders into stretch, dropped back. CAME HOME LATE raced in middle of pack to stretch, dropped back.
