SISTER GENEVIEVE stalked leaders while racing between rivals, dropped to rail into stretch, responded to steady urging in drive and got up in time. PARIS PRINCESS was never far back outside rivals, came three wide into lane, responded and finished well with belated bid. ENDING STORY chased pace while on the outside of foes, loom threat mid stretch, weakened in late going. HIGH SPEED ALI sent to front along rail, went gamely to mid stretch, tired. SILVERWILLDO well back early, swung out four wide into lane, failed to menace in drive. CAPTIVE STORM forwardly positioned along inside for half, not a factor in lane. ELISHA JOY was never threatened. LADY BLUE was outrun.
