Non-winners of a sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs. a race other than maiden, claiming or trial 4 lbs. maidens 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of entry. This race will be limited to Twelve (12) starters. Trophy to the winning owner. High weights preferred. Preference will be given to the horses assigned equal weights based on lifetime earnings. Closed Friday, November 7th with (35) nominations. (If management deems it necessary to take this race off the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile on the main track.)

CASHINMYWRANGLERS was allowed to settle in stride during early running, came between foes three wide into lane, responded to steady urging and wore down leaders in final stages. MARQUEE EVENT chased pace for three quarters, responded to gain narrow edge mid stretch, went gamely under pressure to wire but couldn't last. ART THIEF was never far back along inside, responded to move nearest pace mid stretch, went gamely before tiring in final stages. PERFECT BULL rallied from middle of pack three wide into lane, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, lacked the needed late kick in drive. HARBOUR CITY well back along inside to stretch, lacked the needed response in drive. RUN OFF RIVER trailed for half, raced four wide into lane, passed tiring foes. BRONZE FOX stalked leaders for three quarters, gave way. HUFF DADDY hustled to front, set pace for three quarters, faded. MESSY MARVIN raced along inside, never a factor. NO ADVANCE forwardly positioned outside rivals for half, came three wide into stretch, failed to threaten. THATS A GOOD THING was always outrun. MAGNILOQUENT was never close.
