Footnotes

POP HIT stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, responded when asked to gain the margin at the eighth pole and was well clear while under steady urging. BLAZEN SUMMER well placed from the outside early, inched closer entering the turn, responded but could only gain the place. AMEN BABY up close early from the outside, moved closer entering the turn, responded but could not keep pace. KIP AWAY chased the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could not sustain the effort. KITTEN IN A PINCH far back early, advanced outside, responded

and finished well but too late. CAPTAIN BILLY could only improve position. I ALBERT could only pass tired ones. GOOD TO GREAT was no factor. BANG ON was no threat. IRISH DREAMER broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear entering the turn then stopped. BATESVILLE chased the early pace and tired. JAZZMANS DREAM pressed the early pace and tired. THAT'S PAR was never close. LENNY'S HOLD'EM had a steady fade.
