GREEN DIGGER broke alertly to front, rated well with clear lead into stretch, went unchallenged, ridden out to wire while increasing margin. OUR SACRED HONOR stalked leaders from outset, no match for winner but went gamely to gain second spot. SCRAPPY ROO chased leader to mid stretch, gave way. UP COUNTRY well back for half, came four wide into lane, finished with a mild rally. AGOSTO'S TUNE saved ground to no avail. CHIP HUNTER trailed for half along inside, passed tiring foes in lane. TURNLEFTATTHELIGHT forwardly positioned into stretch, faded. ROTARY was never a factor. LUMBERJACK CAT raced in middle of pack outside foes for half, faded. DIAMANTE DE ORO was never a threat. CONGA ROCK forwardly positioned for half, stopped.
