### Footnotes

KING CORAL stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded entering the drive and was just up the final strides. INCLINED TO WIN dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the second turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole but was caught late. RING IT UP allowed to settle, advanced inside entering the second turn, responded and was gaining late. RUMORSBOUTME unhurried early, steadily advanced entering the second turn, responded and finished well. STATLER dueled from between foes and tired. ROUGHOUT OKIE could only pass tired ones. MAJORCA SUN dueled from the outside and tired. GOSPEL HOUR was no factor. EASY OKIE was never close.
