Footnotes

STAND WATIE up close early from the inside, tracked the early pace up the backstretch, remained forward entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and was clear late while under steady urging. RED CAJUN stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded to pressure but could not reach the winner. JAGGED EDGE well placed from the inside, inched forward up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the second turn, responded to duel through the drive but could not keep pace. BRUCEVILLE dueled from the outside early, remained in a forward position up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the drive, dueled through the drive but tired late. G FROST far back early, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the drive, made a bid but could not sustain the effort. SWANK HANK could only pass tired ones. SPODIE ODIE forced the early pace from the outside inched closer entering the second turn, remained forward but had nothing left. HUNT FOR ROSES was no factor. GOLD STAR ALERT had a steady fade. CANNONEER forced the early pace from the outside and tired. SAALEM INTENT showed little. MONARCH'S CHANT dueled from the inside and gave way.
