MISS HOCKADAY stalked the early pace from the inside, dropped back slightly entering the second turn, responded along the rail and was clear late while kept to task. SLIDE ON BYE broke sharp from the outside to gain the early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, dueled through the second turn, remained engaged through the drive but could not match strides. LOOKINFORCHANGE well placed from the inside, dueled through the second turn, remained in a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. PLEASANTLY BLESSED chased the early pace from the inside, altered outside for the drive but had nothing left. SKEDEE forced the early pace from the inside and tired. ACANELLA was never close and pulled up entering the drive and vanned off.
