SHARIK stalked the early pace from the inside, tracked the leaders up the backstretch, inched closer entering the second turn, made a bid along the rail and was up the last strides. WHY WONDER WHY broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, was engaged entering the second turn, fought through the drive with FRIENDLY SUMMER, gained a short margin over that one deep stretch but was caught late. FRIENDLY SUMMER chased the early pace from the outside, reached a forward position entering the second turn, dueled with WHY WONDER WHY through the drive but could not keep pace. GRAND OPRY pressed the early pace from the inside, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. SCARLETT THREAD went evenly. MILITARY MOTHER was no factor. OUR MISS BROOKSIDE was no threat. WHEELING WINI forced the early pace and faded. PASSION TALK showed little. SMOOTH SEA was never close.
