LITTLE WAGON was allowed to settle in stride early, commenced bid circling rivals leaving far turn, came four wide into stretch, responded to strong handling to gain command and drew off. JUDYS FAVORITE SON was never far back, came three wide into stretch, responded to loom danger mid stretch, hung but held on to second spot. GORGE in middle of pack along rail into stretch, responded to be nearest pace mid stretch, weakened. PROSPECTING AGENDA was unhurried early, moved up leaving far turn, came four wide when making bid into stretch, flattened out. LONE STRIKER failed to menace. FLIM FLAM MAN stalked pace from outset, moved up outside rivals when making bid into stretch, took slight advantage mid stretch, gave way. CAUSE HE'S IRISH forwardly positioned along rail for half, had no rally. PARKLANE CHUGALUG chased pace for half, faded. NATGEAR hustled to front, stopped after half.
