RANGE WAR broke alertly to front, rated well into stretch with clear advantage, went unchallenged, ridden out to wire. BAD BIG AL chased leaders throughout, went gamely but unable to reach winner in drive and settled for the second spot. SILVERBDANCING stalked leaders from outset, came three wide into lane, had no rally. PLATINUM DEVIL within striking distance along inside from outset, lacked needed response. WORLD WIDE WEB came five wide from middle of pack into stretch, failed to menace in drive. FIRST CLASS BRASS was not a factor. SHAKOTAN was not a threat. DEAL A KING was outrun. UNO DUCKSY blew both turns, never close. OUTFITTER was pulled up before quarter mile in apparent distress, vanned off.
