

**Footnotes**

WALLY'S CHOICE outran early, tracked the pace up the backstretch while inside, reached a striking position entering the second turn, altered course outside, responded when asked to find his best stride in time. GOLDEN GLEN unhurried early while inside, crept closer up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the second turn, responded to pressure while inside upper stretch but could not keep pace. CRYPTOGRAPH stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, gained a short advantage at the eighth pole but flattened out late. SLEW SLAYER well placed from between foes, tracked the pace up the backstretch, advanced entering the second turn, responded when asked but was too late. FOREIGN JUSTICE went evenly. BRITT'S JULES chased the pace from the inside, inched closer up the backstretch, gained the advantage entering the second turn but faltered in the drive. ROAROFVICTORY could only pass tired ones. QUINTONS GOLD RUSH dueled from the outside and tired. GAMBLIN dueled from the inside and tired. COMMANDER BUCK had a steady fade. MR. JESTER up close outside, stopped after going three quarters and was eased both stretch and finish.
