STAKES Remington MEC Mile S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS. No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box. Starters to pay \$500 additional with \$75,000 added. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: 120 lbs. Non-winners of \$18,000 twice allowed, 2 lbs.; \$18,000 once, 4 lbs.; \$15,000, 6 lbs.; maidens, 8 lbs. The top three finishers in the Remington MEC mile will get an automatic nomination to the Oklahoma Derby in 2005. The winner will receive an all fees paid entry into the Oklahoma Derby in 2005. This race will be limited to 12 starters. Preference: Stakes winning or stake-placed horses in graded/group stakes (in order I,II,III), then lifetime earnings. Lifetime earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. Trophy to the winning Owner, Trainer and Jockey. Closed Friday November 12, with (35) nominations.

SMOOTH BID broke well from between foes to stalk the early pace, gradually inched closer up the backstretch, made a bid entering the second turn, dueled through the stretch, brushed with SILVER HAZE mid stretch and was just up the final strides. SILVER HAZE well placed from the inside, advanced up the backstretch, got closer as the field entered the second turn, responded to pressure to duel with the winner, was brushed by that one deep stretch and outfinished in a game effort. CITY CODE forced the early pace outside, steadily advanced entering the second turn, made a bid to gain a short advantage, dueled through the stretch but was outfinished. RUBIALEDO well placed from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, made a bid entering the second turn but was no match late. LEAR FORCE unhurried outside, could only improve position. ULZANA was no factor. CHASIN THE WIND was no threat. YABBA DABBA YOU was no menace. YEAH BUDDY had little impact. DEELITEFUL DUDE was never close. EL GRANDE SEVILLE dueled from the outside and gave way. SOONER PRIDE dueled from the inside and gave way.
