CAT HOP rated off early pace while not far back, came three wide into lane, responded to strong handling during stretch drive and got up in final strides. GATHERING SKY chased pace from outset, responded to gain advantage mid stretch, went gamely to wire but couldn't last in a game effort. HESTER'S PATTI SUE was never far back, swung out five wide entering stretch, finished with a mild belated rally. SAWEEET allowed to settle early, swung out four wide when commencing bid into stretch, lacked response in drive. PRIZE PACKET stalked leaders to top stretch, tired. SPEAK'N THE BLUES along inside while forwardly positioned into stretch, had no rally. DEAR JESSE was not a menace. OKLAHOMA WIND never a factor. LUCKY CRITTER hustled to front, held clear advantage for three quarters, faded. MY ADVERSARY was not a threat. PANCHOS IRISH GAL forwardly positioned along rail to stretch, quit.
