Footnotes

COUNTERFEIT HALO was allowed to settle early, circled leaving far turn, came five wide into lane, responded to steady urging, surged clear in late going. MIDSUMMER MAGIC sent to front, rated well on short lead into stretch, responded to challenge in drive before weakening in late going. OSWEGO stalked leaders throughout, lacked the needed late kick in final stages. BABY DOLL BLUES unhurried along inside for half, moved up into lane, rallied belatedly while racing between rivals in drive to wire. SAMBA G forwardly positioned outside rivals into stretch, lacked needed response. RAINE OF COURAGE chased pace to mid stretch, tired. R BRIDGE IT wide while well back for half, improved position in lane. LADY COSMO saved ground, failed to menace. PRIVATE AFTANON forwardly positioned along inside to stretch, gave way. LADY L forwardly positioned for half, faded. CANOPY was not a threat. SPEED WAGON raced in middle of pack for half, dropped back.
