FIRE GAME was never far back outside rivals, came three wide into stretch, responded to gain nod mid stretch, kept to task during run to wire to prove best. MAYDAY MAN was allowed to settle early, came three wide when making bid into stretch, responded to handling, got up to nail second spot. BOSS M came from id pack five wide into stretch, finished with a solid belated mid track rally. EDDIE'S HOLIDAY well back at the half, swung six wide into stretch, finished with a mild mid track bid. JESUIT WARRIOR hustled to front, set pace into stretch, tired. TED THE PROTECTOR came five wide from middle of pack into lane, lacked response when asked. IRISH DARCY raced along inside, was never a factor. GOOD THING GOING was never a threat. RAINY MOUNTAIN stalked leaders on the outside for half, gave way. RICH MONARCHOS showed little. CHEEP SONGLASSES chased pace for half, dropped back. AGGIE APPEAL stalked early leaders along rail, faded steadily after quarter mile. CAPTAIN RICOCHET was outrun. GET R DONE G W was never close.
