Footnotes

TRABAJADORA stalked the early pace from between foes, advanced entering the turn, altered outside for the drive and was just in time the final stride. L. S. HANA up close from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, made a bid entering the stretch to gain a short advantage but was outfinished. EMBERS TO ASHES far back early, advanced outside entering the turn, responded and was gaining late. WILD LOUISE chased the pace from between foes but had no late response. BRETT'S CAT forced the pace from between foes and tired. SMOOTH ROCKET forced the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. BRANJOLISA was no factor. TRUE LUCK broke well from the inside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear entering the turn but tired in the drive. SILVER STRAND had little interest. BRANDY VEE was never close.
