VERIFY stalked leaders while racing on the outside, moved willingly three wide of rivals into lane, took over mid stretch, unchallenged and ridden out to wire. BISCAY BAY well back along inside early, swung out six wide into stretch, lugged in top stretch, righted and rallied for second spot but no threat to winner. PUTTHEHAMMERDOWN chased pace into stretch, tired. EVERY TIME rallied from middle of pack five wide into lane, steady top stretch, failed to sustain bid. LONGER THAN UNO raced along inside, failed to menace. CAPE TIME stalked leaders while wide for half, gave way. PENFOLD forwardly positioned along inside for half, not a factor in drive. DAUGHTRY showed little. FLOODGATE never threatened. SUNDAY SAMURAI hustled to front, set pace for half, quit. COFFEE CREEK ROAD was outrun. TEXAS REBEL was never close.
