SUPERIOR CAT dueled from the outside early, dueled through the stretch, dropped back slightly at the eighth pole, responded to come again and was just up the final stride. ELISHA JOY stalked the early pace from between foes, advanced entering the turn, responded upper stretch to split rivals, dueled through the stretch but was outfinished. DAR MA LEE chased the early pace from between foes, inched closer entering the turn, responded and finished well. DANDIONE up close from the inside early, remained a forward factor entering the stretch but had no late response. OK EXPRESS dueled from the inside and tired. SUSSIEONE could only improve position. TEETAU MARIE forced the pace outside and tired. BUNNY BUBBLE went evenly. CRAFTYRHONDA was no factor. BELVA CASEY was never close. PEARL'S HICKEY had a steady fade. LONG LEGGED LUCY was always outrun.
