Footnotes

DEPUTY WHY dueled along rail from outset, responded to strong handling during run to wire to take command and draw clear. VIVA GATO dueled on the outside of rivals from outset, responded to gain advantage at the half, went gamely under pressure in drive before weakening in late going. BANDIT EYES was never far back, came three wide into stretch. lacked the needed late kick in drive. MOONWARD well back for half, swung six wide into stretch, finished with a belated mid track rally. VOLTURI within striking distance outside rivals from outset, moved up to loom danger into stretch, gave way in lane. BROKEANDBUSTED saved ground to no avail. LANGALEER raced in middle of pack, lacked response. HURRICANE HOUSTON was never a factor. WHO MADE THE CAKE dueled while racing between foes for half, faded. TORNADO STORM was not a threat. COUNTRY LAKE was outrun. HENNY HALL forwardly positioned outside rivals for half, dropped back.
