STEAL YOUR FACE well back for half, swung five wide into stretch, responded to strong handling while racing mid track, got up in time. HERECOMESTHEMANNOW within striking distance from outset, came between foes when making bid into stretch, gained narrow edge at the half, went gamely to wire only to be outfinished on the wire. MARQ FRENCH stalked leaders from start, moved up three wide into stretch when making bid, went gamely before weakening in late going. QUICK MOVE allowed to settle in strides for half, moved up along inside when making bid into stretch, flattened out in lane. LAIDBACKLYNNY chased pace from start, responded to open clear advantage at the half, gave way in lane. TI TOWNSHIP trailed for half, failed to menace. FIFTH DATE hustled to front, dueled for half, faded thereafter. BONDSTEEL was never a threat.
