Footnotes

CHANDAS stalked leaders from outset while saving ground, came off rail three wide into stretch, responded to gain lead mid stretch, kept to task, remained clear to wire. SUNSET RIDER well back for three quarters, came five wide into stretch, responded to handling, finished well, but too late. MIZZEN DIXIE stalked leaders along inside from outset, moved up to be nearest pace mid stretch, went gamely but hung in late going. DELWOOD came eight wide from middle of pack into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. STREET HAVEN moved up six wide from well back into stretch, finished

with a mild rally. PERSONALITY KID forwardly positioned outside rivals into stretch, had no rally. STRAIGHT FLASH raced in middle of pack into stretch, failed to menace. RARE LUKEY hustled to front, set pace for three quarters, faded in lane. MONEY RULES trailed from outset, showed little. STEEL BLUE SLEW was never a factor. JESS' DITTY BAG well back from outset, never a threat. QUIET KING wide from outset, outrun. FULL FLEDGE RUMOR was never close. SOLDADO forwardly positioned along inside for half, stopped.
