POWER BALL SLEW was allowed to settle in stride early, came three wide when making bid into stretch, responded to strong handling while racing mid track, got up in late going. KIPSANDY stalked leaders from outset, came four wide into stretch, responded to handling, took over mid stretch, went gamely to wire only to outfinished in the end. LAND RUN was allowed to settle early, moved up along inside into stretch, finished with a solid belated rail rally. THREECLOCKFRIDAY well back at the half, raced four wide when entering stretch, failed to menace while racing mid track in drive. CHIEF TWO SPOTS raced in middle of pack, never a factor. MIKA'S TOPGUN chased pace into stretch, gave way. DON'S OKIE LUCK hustled to front, set pace into stretch, faded. BERNIES LEGACY was never a serious threat. SHOTGUN RYDER was always outrun.
