ESSCALATOR broke to front, rated well with clear lead into stretch, responded to mild urging, remained clear to wire. MAKESHIFT stalked leaders along inside throughout, no match for winner but clearly best of others. ETBAUER'S HIT was never far back, swung five wide into stretch, lacked response when asked. BATTLE CREEK LADY chased leaders into stretch, gave way in lane. MACHO SISTA was allowed to settle early, moved up along inside into stretch, finished with a mild rail rally. SPOON FACE failed to menace. TRUE N TIME well back at the half, improved position. ROSIE CHATAIN forwardly positioned along inside for half, faded. CHENA MISS was never a factor. MISSTHEWAYSHEMOVES wide from outset, showed little. GOSPEL FAIRA never threatened. HIDDEN AGENDA was outrun.
