WHISKEY DOUBLE dueled from between foes for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive, gained a short advantage deep stretch then was all out to last. PRIMAL TOUCH outrun early, circled rivals on the turn, responded when sat down for the drive and was getting to the winner but too late. SLADEN K dueled from the outside for the early lead, battled through the turn, fought through the drive with the winner but could not keep pace. RED THORN chased the early pace from the inside, made a bid along the rail and finished well. BARNEY R went evenly. GOSPEL HOUR was no factor. GOLDANDSILVER dueled from the inside and tired. BIG RED OKIE forced the early pace from the outside then retreated.
