FRED HENRY was never far back along inside, came three wide when making bid into stretch, responded to take command and draw off in late going. OKIE SLEW chased pace on the outside from outset, came three wide into stretch, responded to gain nod mid stretch, went gamely but couldn't last in the end. IN YOUR WORLD stalked leaders from outset along rail, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out in late going. BULLERINA KID hustled to front, set pace into stretch, went gamely before tiring, pulled up in distress and vanned off. CHEROKEE VISION was allowed to settle for half, raced five wide into stretch, improved position in lane. MISTER VAQUERO raced in middle of pack, lacked response when asked. WINABUCK vied with early leaders, faded after a half. DUANES LITLETADPOL trailed at the half, passed tiring foes. BIG RED OKIE was never a factor. CREDIT FORWARD forwardly positioned on the outside of rivals for quarter mile, faded steadily thereafter. HAY MERCEDES was never a threat. K COMPANY was outrun. CATGAR was

never close.
