LIMEHOUSE BLUES was allowed to settle early, moved willingly around rivals leaving far turn, came five wide into stretch, took over and ridden out to wire in late going. F C GOMANGO was never far back, came three wide when making bid into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, no match late for winner but gamely held unto second spot. YUKONRUN was never far back along inside, came off rail five wide top stretch, finished with a solid belated bid. MAGIC EMPIRE stalked leaders into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. VIVALAFREDDIE trailed after a half, swung six wide into stretch, improved position. LIL MAN WILL hustled to front, set pace for half, gave way. BAD MAN BROWN dueled on the outside of rivals to stretch, faded. TOUCH OF ICE was never a threat. MY DEBIT CARD vied for early lead, dropped back after quarter mile.
