INCA MISS unhurried early, tracked the pace from the outside up the backstretch, responded entering the second turn and wore down foes late. I FORGIVE YOU up close early from the outside, dueled through the second turn, remained engaged through the drive but could not match strides late. MIRACLE LAKE allowed to settle early, advanced entering the second turn, responded and was gaining late. LAUGHING FITZ pressed the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, dueled through the drive but could not keep pace. DIXIELAND PARADE chased the early pace outside but had no late response. LENOX LANE was no factor. BUENA FORTUNA (MEX) was never close. DOMINIKA (MEX) broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, dueled up the backstretch, remained engaged through the drive but gave way.
