CATALE KEY well placed from the outside early, inched closer entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive, and was clear late while kept to task. BALM broke sharp from the inside, dueled for the early lead, gained a clear margin entering the turn, remained clear at the eighth pole but could not last. PRIVATE NATIVE stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, responded but could not match strides. LA BELLE BEAR pressed the early pace from between foes, made a bid and finished well. SILVER BULLET BABE could only pass tired ones. RED LION HEART was no factor. ROCKPORT LOVER was no threat. JUST MAID dueled from the inside and tired. TIGER'S SPLENDOR forced the early pace and tired. PERSIMMON PUDD'IN was always outrun.
